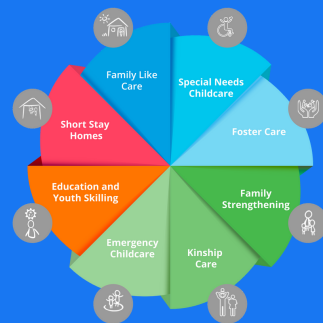

IN ACTION



The Assam Government has granted Rani* from SOS Children's Village Shillong with a new scooter for performing exceptionally well in her 12th grade final exams. 2 more children are set to receive scooters from the Government owing to their exceptional academic performance.

Hon'ble Chief Minister of Haryana, Mr. Manohar Lal ji, was in conversation with the children living in childcare institutions of Haryana at the Chief Minister's residence, 'Sant Kabir Kutir'. During this meeting, future goals and expectations were discussed with the 'Harihar Yojana' beneficiaries. Eight girls from Greenfields and one girl from Faridabad had been selected for 'Harihar Yojana.' They also got an opportunity to meet the Hon'ble CM of Haryana

IN ACTION



A milk collection centre was inaugurated at the FSP cluster Cahandimau, Begusarai in collaboration with Maa Vaishno Devi dairy farm with the help of NABARD. This intervention will impact the FSP caregivers and the community at large who are working in the cattle sector. Maa Vaishno Devi dairy farm has also provided tools worth INR 30,000. The beneficiaries have started milk collection in the cluster

Vaccination camp was organised in collaboration with the Anganwadi centre at FS location Rajeev Nagar Extension for the community people. All children aged 9 months to 5 years will be vaccinated with Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR) Vaccination



FSP Begusarai (Nalanda) Nepura cluster collaborated with Dakshin Bihar Gramin Bank to open bank accounts of SHGs. This programme included team members from the District office, the Social Activist, and the weaving community President. The bank team not only opened the account of the beneficiaries but also conducted a session on financial literacy to make them aware of the different schemes and programmes of the government, which will help them to avail the schemes on their own

A training programme was organised at the FSP Hojai on SHG Book Keeping for newly enrolled SHG members from Dhanuhar basti under Vishal Mega Mart CSR Fund. An ASRLM expert conducted the training; during the session, he talked about the importance of SHG and how they will be benefitted from being a part of it. A total of 50 participants attended the training
